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4) You must receive Jesus Christ as your Savior. At this moment, will you place your faith in Jesus Christ who died for your sins, was buried, and rose from the dead?

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“Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference.” (Romans 3:22)

5) You must do it now! This could be your last opportunity to respond.

“...behold, now is the day of salvation.” (II Corinthians 6:2)

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THE TEN COMMANDMENTS



EXODUS 20:1-17

The Ten Commandments are God's holy moral law, have you kept them all? Let's see if you are truly a good person, have you ever put anything above God? Have you honored your parents? Have you ever told a lie? Have you ever taken God's name in vain? These are a few of the Ten Commandments found in The Holy Bible (Exodus 20:1-17). The law reveals our sins, The Bible says "...the strength of sin is the law" (I Corinthians 15:56) and "...for by the law is the knowledge of sin" (Romans 3:20). The reality is no one has ever kept The Ten Commandments perfectly, we all have fallen short of it. The law reveals God's holiness and His perfect standard of righteousness. The Bible says "For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all" (James 2:10). It only takes one sin to be guilty of breaking them all. Sin is missing the mark on God's perfect righteous standard. God will not lower His standard for anyone. Right now at this moment you are guilty of violating God's law, you are currently condemned (John 3:18), God's wrath abides on you (John 3:36), and when you die God will cast you into hellfire for all eternity (Revelation 20:15). Friend, your ONLY hope of getting into heaven is through Jesus Christ. The

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Ten Commandments serves to point us to Jesus alone as our only hope and Savior (Acts 4:12).

1) Accept that you're a sinner.

"As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one." (Romans 3:10)

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23)

2) The just punishment we all rightly deserve for our sins is eternity in hell.

"And shall cast them into the furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth." (Matthew 13:50)

"And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire." (Revelation 20:15)

3) Recognize that Jesus Christ died for your sins. Because there was no other way to resolve this problem of our sin, God sent his own Son to die in our place on the cross of Calvary. He paid for all of our sins in the past, present, and future.

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
