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4) You must receive Jesus Christ as your Savior.

At this moment, will you place your faith in Jesus Christ who died for your sins, was buried, and rose from the dead?

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."
(John 3:16)

5) You must do it now!

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The No. 1 Question

You should ask yourself

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If you were to die today, would you be in heaven? You may say “yes” because you believe you are a good person or you've never killed anyone or you do many good works. But the truth is no one is good because The Bible has declared *“For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not”* (Ecclesiastes 7:20). The Bible has also declared that all our good works are filthy rags before a holy God (Isaiah 64:6). You see friend, in order for us to go to heaven we would have to be perfect like God and without sin. Sin is missing the mark on God's perfect righteous standard. God is not going to lower His standard for anyone, He is too holy to overlook sin. But there is good news to all of this, and the answer is Jesus Christ which alone is the Savior of mankind and the only way of getting into heaven (Acts 4:12, John 14:6). Continue reading to see what YOU must do to get to heaven.

1) Accept that you are a sinner. We have all lied, stolen, hated another, looked with lust, used God's name irreverently (blasphemy), coveted, placed other things before God (idolatry). We have all missed God's righteous standard.

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“As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one.” (Romans 3:10)

“For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.” (Romans 3:23)

2) The just punishment we all rightly deserve for our sins is eternity in hell.

“And shall cast them into the furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.” (Matthew 13:50)

“And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.” (Revelation 20:15)

3) Recognize that Jesus Christ died for your sins.

Because there was no other way to resolve this problem of our sin, God sent his own Son to die in our place on the cross of Calvary. He paid for all of our sins in the past, present, and future.

“...Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures.” (I Corinthians 15:3,4)

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
